BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROGRAMME

Youth Hostels Association of India, East Khasi Hills District Unit is organizing a 3-night 4-day Wari Chora Expedition, covering the places in Garo Hills, from **10th Feb to 13th Feb 2026**.

PARTICIPATION

Participation in the programme is open to all educational Institution, individuals and recognized units of YHAI. Participants must bear all travel expenses from their place to Youth Hostel Shillong and back. The Age bar for participants is from **15 years to 65** for male and **15 years to 55** for female.

PARTICIPATION FEES

Rs. 12,500/- only per head; the fee includes simple vegetarian food, accommodation (dormitory/room), — transportation, supervision, guidance and entry fees. Payment can be made only by depositing the fees in our Bank Account through Net Banking, NEFT/RTGS (DD. Demand Draft is not accepted)

Members desirous to join this programme may fill the Registration Form along with duly supported by a medical fitness certificate and YHAI membership ID during the time of reporting at the Base Camp

ROUTE AND SCHEDULE

Day 1 : Reporting at Govt. Youth Hostel Shillong from 4 PM onwards
: 6 PM Orientation and training.

Day 2 : After flag off (around 7am) participants will be transferred by bus to Siju via Nongstoin/Guwhati. After arrival participants will visit swimming pool Nasep Chiring then siteseeing of Siju Simsang River. Evening dinner and overnight stay.

Day 3 : Morning: Begin the day with early breakfast. Visit Jadesil Fish Sanctuary.

Daytime: Drive to Wari Chora via an offroad trail. Enjoy a boating experience at Wari Chora. Followed by Lunch.

Evening: Conclude the day with dinner

Day 4 : Morning begin the day with an early breakfast and then participants will proceed to famous Siju cave and RONCHANG rock formation followed by transportation to paltan bazar/ISBT Guwhati/Shillong via Rajapara.

HOW TO REACH YOUTH HOSTEL SHILLONG

The nearest Railway Station and International Airport is Guwhati. Sumo and Tourist Taxi are available from the Railway Station and International Airport to Shillong which is about 100kms away from Railway Station and about 130kms from Airport. Youth Hostel is located opposite the Central Telegraph Office and near the State's Secretariat which is a walking distance from the sumo/tourist taxis stand (Police Bazar).

WHAT YOU SHOULD BRING

Beside their own personal belongings, the participants need to carry jacket, t-shirt, umbrella/raincoat, torch, trekking bag pack/rucksack, sneakers suitable for trekking/ trekking shoes, cap, sunglasses, tiffin box, spoon, water bottle etc.

The Program Includes:

- Accommodation
- Transportation
- Guide Fees
- Meals (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)
- Transportation (For warichora Gipsy or any 4X4 car)

The Program Excludes:

- Activity Fees
- Boating Fees
- Unexpected expenditure due to natural calamities

TERMS & CONDITION

- Only members of YHAI are eligible to participate on first come first serve basis.
- **One group of 18 participants which will be on a first come first serve basis.**
- The minimum age for joining the expedition is 15 years.
- In case any participants are unable to join the program, application for cancellation in writing or email to the Unit Secretary **15 Days** before the scheduled date booked by the

individual and avail 50% of the participation fee paid. If such notice is received after the time given no refund will be admissible.

- Participants shall not hold any of YHAI Organizer responsible wholly or partially for any injury, accidents, illness and such other unforeseen eventualities during expeditions.

CERTIFICATES


Participants who successfully completed the expedition and abide by the discipline of the programme will be awarded Certificate.
